

Randomly. Employers should have written policies that explain that they do random, unannounced drug screening. **Reasonable suspicion.** This can be necessary if an employee shows signs of inebriation, such as slurred speech or stumbling.




Should I Screen For Marijuana?

Most states have legalized some forms of medical and/or recreational marijuana usage. In most cases, employers can and do screen for THC. However, taking adverse actions in relation to a positive cannabis test result is sometimes prohibited based on location due to the extended period in which it stays in one's system. Much like alcohol, it may be legal to consume during a candidate or team member's personal time based on local laws.

Exceptions are generally made for safety-sensitive positions, such as healthcare, law enforcement or those that involve operating machinery.
